The inventor of dynamite, Alfred Nobel, was unhappy that his invention had been used in non-peaceful ways. He had made a lot of money from the invention, and he wanted to do something to help people.

When he died he left a large sum of money to be given as prizes to people who had made valuable contributions to the good of humanity.

Beginning in 1901 the money was given in five awards yearly. The first three were for the most important discovery or invention in physics, chemistry and physiology and medicine. The fourth was for the most distinguished literary work of an idealistic nature, and the last was for the most effective work in the interest of international peace.

In the 1960's another award was added in the field of economics. The prizes are awarded in December of each year. Someone has to nominate a candidate for the prize; a person cannot submit their own name. Several organizations choose the winner. The Nobel Institute is located in Stockholm, Sweden.
