PREPOSITIONS OF TIME

A. At 8 o'clock On Monday In April

- **At:** 8 o'clock.
10:30.
Midnight, etc.

I start work **at 8 o'clock**
The shops close **at 5:30**
- **On:** Sunday(s) / Monday(s), etc.
25 April / 6 June, etc.
New Year's Day, etc.

Bye! I'll see you **on Friday**.
What do you usually do **on Sundays**?
The concert is **on 22 November**.
- **In:** April / June, etc.
2003/ 1968, etc.
Summer / Spring, etc.

I'm going on holiday **in October**.
Emma was born **in 1983**.
The park is beautiful **in spring**.

EXAMPLES

B. We say:

- **At the weekend**

Are you going away **at the weekend**.
- **At night**

I can't sleep **at night**.
- **At Christmas / at Easter**

Where will you be **at Christmas?** (but **on Christmas Day**)
- **At the end of...**

I'm going in holiday **at the end of** October.
- **At the moment**

Are you busy **at the moment**.

C. In the morning / in the afternoon / in the evening

1. I always fell good **in the morning**.
2. Do you often go out **in the evening**?

On Monday morning / on Tuesday afternoon / on Friday evening / on Saturday night,
etc.

1. I'm meeting Joanne **on Monday morning**.
2. Are you doing anything **on Saturday night**?

D. We do *not* use **at / on / in** before:

E. In five minutes / in a few days / in six weeks / in two years etc.

- Hurry! The train leaves **in five minutes**.
(= it leaves five minutes from now)
- Bye! I'll see you **in a few days**.
(= a few days from now)

USE:

IN + year / month / morning / afternoon / evening.

ON + day of the week / date.

AT + specific time on the clock.

We use *in* to talk about spaces.

- ✓ He is *in* the classroom.

Under means covered by, having something on top.

- ✓ A rug *under* the chair.

By and *next to* mean near, close to.

- ✓ The children are *by* the river.
- ✓ I live *next to* the library.

Between means in the space separating two objects or points.

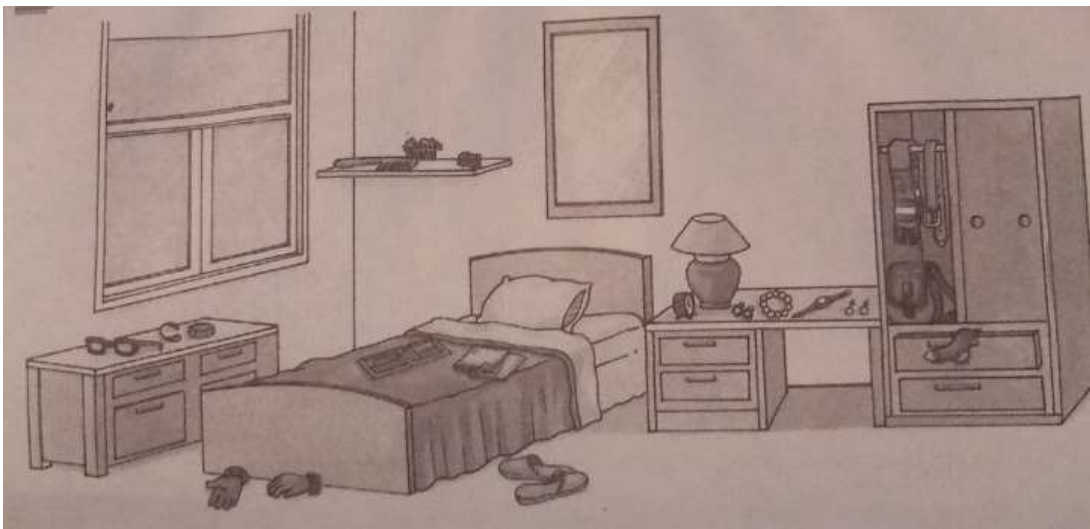
- ✓ The clock is *between* the books and the lamp.

We use *on* to talk about a surface.

- ✓ The chair is *on* the rug.
