Her / Hers (suyo, de ella)

Its (suyo, de eso)

Our / Ours (nuestro)

Your / Yours (suyo, de ustedes)

Their / Theirs (suyo, de ellos)

I'm your father – Soy tu padre

Tom will be your partner in the dance contest – Tom será tu compañero en el concurso de baile

Barcelona is his hometown – Barcelona es su hogar

Mark is washing his hands – Mark se está lavando las manos (fíjate que en castellano no usamos en estos casos el posesivo)

Her

Her dress is blue – Su vestido es azul

Its

My cat doesn't like to sleep in its cage – A mi gato no le gusta dormir en su caja

Our

This is our house – Esta es nuestra casa

Their

Do you know if their children go to school? – ¿Sabes si sus hijos van a la escuela?
